## what will my child be learning?

- <u>Language Arts</u>: We are completing our study of poetry, prose, and drama. We will soon be starting a novel study on <u>By The Great Horn Spoon</u>.
- <u>Writing</u>: We will continue our study of Opinion/Persuasive Writing. Students have been learning to write multi-paragraph essays which include: an introductory paragraph clearly stating their opinion and 3 reasons, supporting reasons/evidence, and a concluding paragraph clearly restating the thesis/opinion statement with a call to action. The students will be taking the District's Writing Performance Assessment next week on Wednesday, March 6<sup>th</sup>.
- <u>Math:</u> We are finishing Module 8 (Division; Multiplying Fractions & Mixed Numbers) and starting Module 9 (Fractions Comparing, Ordering, Finding Common Denominators; Mass Pounds & Ounces; Capacity Gallons, Quarts, Pints, Fluid Ounces).
- Science: We will finish our Earth Science Unit (Rocks & Minerals)
- <u>Social Studies</u>: We will learn about the economic, social, and political life in California
  from the establishment of the Bear Flag Republic through the Mexican-American War,
  The Gold Rush, and the granting of statehood.
- <u>Gold Rush Day</u>: We need your help to make this year's Gold Rush Day a memorable experience for your child. Your teacher will let you know about details and how/when to sign up.
